Athens State University is located in Athens between Hobbs and Pryor streets. From I-65 North/South get off at Exit 351 and go West on Hwy. 72 about 2 miles. Take Hwy. 31 North by going left and circling under Hwy. 72. Come about 1 1/2 miles until you pass Athens High School. Turn left at the next light which is Pryor Street. The campus is about 3/4 of a mile ahead. The gym is on the left. You may park behind the gym or across the street next to the library. **Registration is in the gym**. Coming from the West on Hwy. 72, turn right and go under Hwy. 72 at Hwy. 31.
